Introduction

Welcome to your Past Life report. Whereas the birthchart is a symbolic road map describing your current life, the Past Lives chart is a blueprint of your previous incarnations. The pages that follow will help shed some light on themes related to your past life instincts. First, let's talk about reincarnation which is the belief that the current incarnation (as depicted by our birthchart) is linked to the lives that we have previously led. This collection of past influences points to particular experiences you might encounter again so that you can further your growth and fully develop your creative potential. These past impressions go far in shaping many of our current thoughts and choices. There are certain gifts a person seems to possess right out of the womb! It's as though destiny or fate leads one to realize these attributes. Of course, we still have to show ambition and make the effort in order to keep our dreams alive. This report may give confirmation to talents that you already know you have or open your eyes to ones that you have yet to discover.

Our past lives are alive and well in our consciousness. This may already be apparent to you. But on the other hand, these experiences can lie beyond the threshold of our conscious mind's awareness. What is doing the remembering, if our mind isn't? Call it your soul, higher consciousness or whatever explanation feels right to you.

Have you ever heard about karma, that great law of cause and effect? An old timeless saying sums up the whole process: "You reap what you sew." There are actions and thoughts that defined us in other lives, or have guided us to where we are in the present. They don't really exert any control over us. We have freedom of choice. That's a strong message to remember when reading this report.

Also, don't panic if you read something that says you were not a perfect person. Nobody is in the current one! Use the report as a learning tool. The idea is to keep developing and evolving. It's balancing the cosmic rhythm of past and present that presents each of us with a challenge. Do we respond positively or negatively? With hope or doubt? Many of our tendencies are linked to previous incarnations. Certain patterns have likely been by our side over many lifetimes. As we grow and expand our awareness, it becomes very possible to step beyond the trappings of past life baggage.

No doubt you will read various sections that seem to contradict each other. Each could be true about you. It's important to realize that many different dimensions of ourselves live within us. Each of us is composed of memories from so many past lives, combined with an assortment of ways we have learned to deal with reality in this life, that make us complex beings. See which descriptions ring true to you as you read through the following pages. You will notice some traits described have a repeating theme.

I hope you find this report an enjoyable ride into your past life instincts and thought patterns. They are somewhere in your consciousness. Perhaps some of what you read will strike a familiar chord. After all, these pages are all about your past life loves, creative pursuits, adventures, travels, highs and lows, over many lifetimes. Happy navigating!

The Past Life Chart Structure

Some technical explanations about the Past Life chart (if you detest technical discussions, then skip this paragraph and jump right into the report!). The Ascendant in this chart starts with the sign on the cusp of the 12th house, instead of the traditional method of using the sign on the 1st house cusp, which is the sign rising on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also, the Past Life birthchart houses are counted clockwise, rather than the conventional way of counterclockwise. In other words, since the 12th house becomes the Ascendant, the sign on the cusp of the 11th house now begins the 2nd house, etc., around the chart wheel. What is considered the Ascendant or 1st house in the traditional chart becomes the 12th in the Past Life chart. Your planets remain in the same sign placements, but now occupy different houses, in this new chart. The planets in signs are interpreted in your report from a past lives perspective.

Something interesting to consider in thinking of the houses in a clockwise direction, they are actually now moving in the same direction as the Nodes of the Moon. As you will read in the report the Moon's nodes are strong past life or karmic points in a chart. Their retrograde motion is clockwise meaning they share the same life biorhythms as the houses of the Past Life chart. By traveling backward, or clockwise, through the houses, you are being regressed back into a past life analysis. Enjoy your ride down memory filled lanes!

The Passport

In this section are the first, middle and last names of your Past Lives astrological identity, the Sun, Moon, and Past Lives Ascendant. Each of these three building blocks will be discussed as to how they actively shaped many of your former lives. But before you meet these three key players, you will start your tour through memory lane with the North Node of the Moon. The North Node contains a special message about what was your overall life purpose. It was a constant rhythm pulsating in your consciousness to keep you on target toward your true purposes. It was a celestial compass trying to guide you to walk your talk with greater clarity. So sit back, and enjoy reading your past lives primer.

Node in Capricorn

You had a history of taking the roles you assumed quite seriously. One of your key impulses was determining what was worth your time and commitment. Your soul was normally quite sober about reincarnating knowing the work ahead would take great determination. The archetypal theme for your destiny was to be a leader. A crucial lesson was to remember to delegate. You usually attracted responsibility easily so needed to be careful in not trying to do everything yourself. Being more inclusive took a load off of your shoulders.

If you grew too dependent on others, you had just as many problems. Then again, when you made the time for closeness, you were more fulfilled. A trickster was in becoming your own emotional island, hidden away from others. Usually this led to loneliness and feeling empty, no matter how great the outer success. Finding a way to balance the drive to climb the career ladder with having a happy home was a key to the city of happiness. Another way to say this was staying clear about self-reliance and showing you needed someone. You eventually valued a home as a sanctuary. Becoming recognized for accomplishments was a big deal. You grew through meeting individuals that encouraged you to go beyond your fears and letting them really get to know you. Also, it was when you encountered a job that challenged your inner strength that a little voice within tried to guide you with reassurance to the finish line.

Node in 12th house

What types of activities did you participate in that furthered your soul growth? It was when you had faith in your ideals. Your belief system was the force behind everything you did. Self-doubt was what held you back as was trying to be too perfect. A common concern was "how can I find the love I seek without giving up my own true dreams?" When you didn't blindly follow in someone else's footsteps or chase after unrealistic ideas, you managed to stay out of karma's way. Your energy levels peaked when you fell in love. Yes, cupid's arrow found your heart a steady mark. Romance and fulfilling the plea of your highest values inspired your imagination. Knowing your boundaries kept you on track as much as ignoring them occasionally took you down roads of escapism. Knowing that a lover couldn't solve all of your problems, and you had no magic potion to take away those of others, made your path a lot simpler. Somewhere always hiding in the caverns of your memory banks was an intuitive instinct mixed with a tinge of an in-depth analytical ability. When using this wisely and with discernment, a magical guidance and a clear glimpse ahead colored life.

Sun: Creativity, Ego, Self-expression

Sun in Aquarius:

The sign of Aquarius, the water bearer, lighted the mid-winter astrological skies at your birth into this life. Let's explore what significance this had in regard to your past lives. In traditional astrology the keyword phrase for Aquarius is "I know". You had a repeating pattern tied to gaining breakthrough knowledge. An experimental streak followed you from one incarnation to another.

Archetypes for Aquarius include the rebel, inventor and genius. You didn't fit conveniently into the roles assigned to you by others. Surprise excited you.

The cosmic principle at work through many of your past lives was beating to your own drum. You could dance to the tune created by someone else, but at the same time were anxious to tap out a few of your own. The intellect had the edge. This isn't saying you didn't have a heart. It's just that your first impulse was to think. When you allowed yourself to feel, a broader array of possibilities came your way in the form of people and even professions. You came into this life solarized through a sign promoting unique perceptions. This was a theme that ran throughout your lifetimes and was a key to self-mastery. Ingenuity was your coat of arms. You found ego strength through questioning the rules. Being different just to

be different didn't work to your advantage. Your ideas made others wake up if they grew comfortably numb. There were occasions when you were so fond of the old ways that those bringing change were seen as troublemakers. Knowing when to fight for change, or to preserve something better, was a sign of wisdom. It was when you had a clear vision of the future through a lens of clearly defined goals that the present was a more stable and pleasurable landscape.

Sun in 11th house

You had solar power fueling your long-range goals in past lives. A futurist you often were labeled. Though at times you strongly objected to change if it conflicted with your beliefs. Institutions and you didn't always see eye-to-eye. You rebelled against authority you perceived as unjust. Your creative vitality was enlivened through engaging exchanges of ideas. You circulated amongst a wide variety of peers. Pride in your inventiveness was a regular theme. Unconventional thinkers either excited your mind or made it anxiety prone. This depended on your own needs. You could stubbornly persist on getting your own way.

If there was a challenge it was not becoming too aloof or unpredictable. Your next moves were hard for others to anticipate when you became unruly. People admired your individuality. They only wanted their own needs recognized and respected. In some lives you gave up your freedom too easily. This end of the spectrum didn't make you happy either. It was locating the midpoint between self-reliance and depending on others that worked the best. The inventor and trendsetter shined brightly through you. Sometimes these innovative instincts were readily available. In some lives it took a shock or unexpected experience to bring this forward in you. Your self-expression was ignited through going beyond everyday routines that dulled your senses. When you found refreshing life avenues, your insights guided you. You found fulfillment when embarking on a course that promised to bring you into the company of invigorating individuals and experiences.

Moon: Sense of Security, Roots, Feelings

Moon in Sagittarius:

You were lunarized at birth through the sign of Sagittarius. What does this say

about your past life tendencies? An instinctual urge to explore life from multiple directions followed you from one incarnation to another. The family ancestries in past lives were linked by a love of the foreign, and a high-powered belief system.

Your inner landscapes were colored by a strong faith, which sustained you through the tough times. Many called it luck, but didn't see how much effort you put into the positive. Freedom was a word you understood early. You sought after knowledge because it kept you young in spirit and near the heartbeat of developing new trends. The Journey

Saturn: Ambition, Seriousness, Focus, Responsibility

Saturn in Scorpio

Discipline was the natural outcome in being willing to make a commitment to whatever you were trying to master. Saturn in 3rd house

Uranus in 6th house

Stimulation occurred when you created everyday routines with diversity. Doing the same schedule was centering, but you thrived on integrating new material. You detested adjusting to circumstances that took away your autonomy. You were inventive when you mastered a technique, as you became meticulous in making something highly functional. Unique ideas flourished when you didn't fear criticism.

Neptune: Idealism, Romanticism, Intuition, Dreams, Escapism

Neptune in Libra

You believed in ideals that symbolized fairness and justice for all. Your idealism was awakened through the individuals believing in you, and the ones you admired. Talents in the arts were shown in several lives. You liked individuals possessing diplomacy and tact. Stress annoyed you if lasting too long. Denying there was any problems never resolved anything. Romance was a great calling. Love was almost a religion. You liked exotic partners and those willing to move quickly in an atmosphere of celebration. Falling in love with a lack of reality testing was not in your best interest.

A major challenge was in defining the boundaries between you and others. Guilt made you feel too responsible for a person's troubles. Wearing rose colored glasses painted false first impressions of individuals, letting you see what only you chose to perceive. There were times when you could see right into the soul of someone. When you were honest with yourself, you gravitated to the right peers and lovers. You wanted from the deepest part of your soul to get opportunities to

express your gifts and to find a special someone that recognized the true you. You found transcendental growth through not trying to overly please others, and by having the faith to proceed ahead with your most determined effort.

Neptune in 3rd house

In what way were you extra intuitive? It was in regard to immediate ideas. You had a knack for tuning into a plan that might lead to opportunity. You didn't like stressful situations so did your best to keep them from getting started. You could think with great sensitivity and insight. Your idealism influenced your perceptions. You weren't one wanting to be talked out of your dreams and hopes.

It was a test to stay focused when you became distracted by worries or trying to move into too many directions at once. This doesn't mean you weren't capable of concentration. It is just saying that you really needed your attention to be poured into a project before it could be accomplished. Discipline came through the inspiration of your beliefs. Your spirituality was where you drew inner strength and was often the filter by which you examined reality. You were clearer when you stayed centered, whether through meditation or a quiet retreat. You had a sixth sense when it came to figuring out how to adapt to new situations. This helped immensely in responding to a crisis. What was the biggest challenge? It was in not denying what you really knew to be true. You indulged in this behavior to stay in circumstances not so wonderful for you. Faith transformed your denial into a more on target view of better choices. You searched for a purpose that had the sudden potential to sweep you off of your feet.

Pluto: Personal Power, Self-mastery, Rebirth, Loss, Passion

Pluto in Leo

Empowering yourself through creative risk-taking was a past lives tendency. A strong drive to make your plans ring true was forever pulsating through you. Finding pride through giving birth to ideas was a regular pattern. Cheering and promoting emanated from you loudly. You shined brightly with charisma when your accomplishments were recognized. Your enthusiasm often swept people into believing in you. Growing too attached to what you loved was an occasional downfall. Maintaining some objective distance from lovers and your creations

made you easier to like.

There was a shadow. What was it? A fear of losing. When your skin toughened up enough to at least accept a small dose of rejection, you didn't suffer as much. You could fight endlessly to make others accept your proposals and deals. In the end, you had to decide which battles to wage. In some incarnations you actually lacked the confidence to be successful. Therefore, in this latter case you had to find ways to allow the talent to develop. Self-mastery was discovered through allowing authentic self-expression beam brightly from you. You found rebirth or a sense of renewal when listening to your heart, rather than the fear of your self-doubt.

Pluto in 5th house

How did you go about seeking personal empowerment? You accomplished this through a powerful creative self-expression. This was where your true intensity resided. A renewed sense of purpose was discovered when you lived not just for the applause, but for what you really wanted to say about yourself. Your ego bruised easily. You didn't like being second-guessed when it came to your pet projects. You were not really forthcoming about your agendas. Even those closest to you had to figure them out. A powerful self-examination manifested itself when you wondered why your love life had such ups and downs. A compulsive power struggle with partners got you to ask thought provoking questions. Romance ignited your emotions and gave you a sense of ego strength. A shadow frequently followed you into incarnations connected to an irrational urge to be the center of attention. When you found out how to be more aware of others, you found greater fulfillment.

Footnotes

You have already been introduced to the ten planets. Certain planetary pairs in your chart have a special relationship to one another due to particular angular distances separating them, known as aspects. You could say the two planets in an aspect travel and interact together along the same circuit. The following aspects

will be listed under five types. Two are known as the soft aspects: the sextile (60 degrees) and trine (120 degrees). These two aspects generally point to more gentle themes, and therefore will describe past life trends that went very well for you. They indicate a lower voltage of electricity and produced less friction in your mind and through your actions. The planets involved in a trine or sextile are more likely to talk about areas where you flowed without much effort.

The more hard or intense aspects are the conjunction (0 degrees), square (90 degrees) and opposition (180 degrees). They required your best understanding in past lives. Planets that are part of an intense aspect you will notice often indicate lessons that must be learned, and follow us from one incarnation into another until we get them in balance. These higher voltage aspects don't mean the planets operated negatively, only that there was much more force behind them. "Soft" does not mean good and "intense" does not imply bad. It is often the more intense aspects that deepen our soul growth, that is, if we learn how to use their power wisely. If we don't it's like taking one step forward and three back.

It might be helpful to keep some keywords in mind for the aspects. The sextile represents Excitation and Eagerness. The planets in this aspect give clues as to how their energies worked in a stimulating way through you. The trine is a special Harmony. The two planets involved show you were confident of their interacting energies. The conjunction is where two planets are joined at the hip. There is a Fusion or powerful blending of these energies. The square can reveal where you encountered Friction. Pay special attention to these aspects in particular because they denote themes that are strong past patterns. Squares ask us to resolve their conflict by finding creative outlets. The opposition requires a Balancing act. It is similar to a seesaw. Gaining objective awareness about each planet is a key. Remember, it was usually the most intense aspects that stretched you the most in past lives.

Moon conjunct Ascendant

Home was something you were particular about. You lived where you could secure your identity and find comfort. Your moods were intense. They let you know when it was the time to make decisions and get ready for a few changes. You were sometimes too changeable. When you faced your own shortcomings an inner strength prevailed.

Sun conjunct Venus

Relationships played a major role in your life. Being in love made you feel alive. Finding someone willing to let you be yourself was essential. Perhaps the biggest challenge was decisiveness. An attraction to exotic lovers didn't necessarily mean they were the right matches. It was a desire to share your life with a special soul mate that in the end was what added longevity to your romances. Equally important was finding a person with values you could relate to. Over indulgence in the good things on life's plate had to be watched.

Sun square Saturn

You needed to be careful about creating your own obstacles. Forcing things to happen required wise discretion. There were occasions when putting out your most intense energy got the job done. Knowing the difference between trying to excessively control the outcome of a situation, and turning in your best effort was important. You sometimes let reality be too much your teacher, putting your dreams on hold. Then again, this was often due to circumstances imposed on you. Responsibility didn't allow you the luxury of much free time. You did become good at getting much done in short periods of time. Your determination and patience were intense. Delayed gratification made you appreciate whatever you did receive. Problems with authority figures were not uncommon. You needed to be sure not too become too bossy in your own right. You made a good leader when the going got tough. You became a workaholic now and then. Making time for pleasurable escapes kept you balanced.

Mercury square Mars

Argumentative you were. Your mental intensity wasn't always used negatively. On the business playing field, this was useful in negotiating. Being overly critical of yourself or others took you back three steps for everyone you walked forward. Patience required a lot of practice. You had a ferocious work energy that wasn't afraid of challenges or danger. Boredom did scare you and made you feel half crazy. Looking before leaping was the best advice someone could have given you. Yelling to get your own way was met with considerable resistance. Channeling a restless spirit was required.

Mercury trine Jupiter

You had an even keel life philosophy, not wanting to let the unexpected blow you out of the water. It was possible to talk your way out of just about anything. You did sometimes deny reality because it seemed like too much trouble. A positive attitude brought you good luck more often than not.

Mercury oppose Pluto

Relationships brought out your mental intensity. You sized people up as fast as a cat's eyes adjust to the dark, and that's fast! People watching was fun as you tried to figure out what motivated them. You took your time in really letting down your guard. Manipulating situations did occasionally backfire. When it came to lovers and friends it was better to talk straight. You had certain secrets never shared with anyone unless it was a close confidante. Mystery and intrigue surrounded you. Balancing a need for privacy with a fondness for stimulating exchanges with others was required. You possessed a mental toughness that helped you survive loss or a crisis. Processing your interactions with individuals took considerable time. Forgiving someone tested your courage. Letting go of hurtful past memories was freeing. Meeting thought-provoking people started you on a road to an incredible rebirth.

Venus square Saturn

You worked hard to maintain partnerships mainly because you feared rejection. Lovers fell under two categories. They could be very loyal and generous. Then there was the scrooge and cold group. It's no secret who made you feel the best. You had a preference for long-term commitments but only with those you trusted. Warming up to someone took time. You were reserved. But when you found a comfort zone, you were as lively as they came. People were inclined to try to control you, especially if you were willing to let them do it. Power struggles were troublesome. Diplomacy and tact did help you get through situations. You didn't give up easily on those you loved, especially if they did the same for you. Flexibility was the key to happiness in relationships and in seeking comfort.

Mars trine Uranus

A propensity to sense the future goals that would keep you motivated was part of your nature. You sometimes needed encouragement before really believing you had talent. Your closest friends benefited from your fiery spark of enthusiasm. There was good fortune in often not needing to fight for freedom as life generously provided you with great latitude. Though it was important not to take this for granted.

Mars square Pluto

Danger intrigued you. Taking risks was a high. If you listened to the wrong advice you rushed into reckless actions. When you put this raw energy to wise use there was nothing you couldn't do. You were a passionate person needing big challenges in order to feel alive. Self-destructive actions had to be watched. Knowing ahead of time which actions wouldn't get you into trouble came with experience. Allowing loved ones get to know the real you was scary, but liberating.

Jupiter square Midheaven

Being organized wasn't an immediate impulse. You liked to act first and think later. Following hunches occasionally paid off, but sometimes didn't. Exaggerating your qualifications made others not believe you. Your dramatic side didn't bother anyone as much as promising more than could be delivered. Excess indulgences made discipline a challenge. You found absolute happiness when tapping into talents that earned you recognition. You realized eventually that real effort would take you to where you needed to be.

Saturn trine Midheaven

Your sense of timing was better than most. You were not in the habit of forcing the outcome of situations. Ambition was expressed with an ease that in some

respects hid your real intensity.

Uranus square Neptune

An inner restlessness to pursue your dreams occurred throughout some incarnations. It wasn't easy to concentrate on the present unless you had clear vision. The mental and emotional sides of you were in conflict, especially when you experienced guilt. Integrating intense emotions and a strong intellect took patience. Exerting your independence required faith when there were people standing in your way. There were occasions when you too easily sacrificed your goals and ideals to please others. Balancing your intuition with a realistic assessment of what was truly possible was the big challenge.

Uranus oppose Node

You knew that maintaining your freedom was your lifeline. If you became comfortably numb, no longer caring about your personal autonomy, something within you died. Then it took meeting a rebellious soul or having an experience awaken this side of you again. If you went to the extreme of only serving yourself, it was hard for anyone to get real close to you. There was an inventor and innovator pulsating lively inside, just waiting for the chances to be discovered. You didn't fit into traditional institutions unless making great adjustments. This isn't saying there were no instances when your gifts didn't benefit a mainstream society. You had trouble waiting for others to catch up to your thinking! A revolutionary spirit dominated your mind. Your gift was great vision. A shadow was lack of foresight when you moved with reckless abandonment. It took courage and insight to make this very special dimension of your consciousness work in your favor.

Neptune square Node

Your ideals had to be in alignment with your major life purposes or you were never at ease. Perfection was a driving energy. Dealing with everyday reality was tough. You needed structure but defied it. The exception being when you found the life directions that gave you inspirational focus. Irrational fears sometimes kept you from showing your ability. Developing sound reasoning powers was as essential

as having the faith to pursue your dreams.

Just as the Ascendant in the Passport section that began this report was described as a sign serving a special purpose, each of the other eleven houses has a sign that helps define its meaning. What follows is a trip through each of the other past lives houses or environments to give you a view of additional characteristics. First are listed the keywords for each house.

2nd House: Comfort, values, money, ownership.
Scorpio on 2nd house:

You clung to what you owned. It was because you felt you had earned it! Privacy was highly valued. It gave you a sense of power and strength. You didn't always play the game above board. Manipulating a deal to get it to turn in your favor was a talent. A sixth sense for knowing the bottom line helped you in negotiations. You were intense about your values and might even have fought to the death over them! Self-esteem was crucial to your happiness. Letting go of destructive behaviors was liberating.

3rd House: Perceptions, learning, communication, insight.
Libra on 3rd house:

Being able to see both sides of issues was a blessing and a curse. It made you a fair person but not always a happy one. Decisions that had an impact on you emotionally were challenging. This was when getting a clear consensus in your own head might be testy. In trying to please others, a waffling trait did occur. People made you nervous when rushing you to think fast. Anger made you nervous so you liked to resolve differences fast. Overly compromising didn't get you the best results. You were happier when learning to live with your choices.

4th House: Home, security, nurturing, roots.
Virgo on 4th house:

You were prone to worry. Finding an inner sense of security was a challenge. Self-doubt was the biggest test. Finding your self-confidence gave you a whole new lease on life. Cautiousness and suspiciousness about change was a normal pattern. Learning to flow with life's ups and downs brought greater harmony. You were picky about your home as it gave you a feeling of protection.

**5th House: Self-expression, creativity, confidence, romance, risk-taking.
Leo on 5th house:**

The will to create was strong. You never accepted losing or failure easily. Your tendency was to go on fighting till the bitter end. Your stamina to follow through on a course of action was relentless. The exception being if you grew depressed or lost interest. Learning to change directions was a challenge. Success sometimes went to your head. When you didn't become too self-absorbed people liked you more. A lack of attention did hurt your ego. When you didn't look compulsively for admirers, your kingdom was full of gifts and upbeat happenings. A gambler's mentality you sometimes had. Knowing your limits was a key to happiness and balance.

**6th House: Learning skills, work environment, perfection, diet, health.
Gemini on 6th house:**

You enjoyed learning in as many ways as possible, and had a deep desire to sharpen skills. Boredom you feared. You liked being as prepared as possible in order to anticipate change. Your delicate nervous system needed regular exercise to keep you mentally clear. A proneness to a lack of concentration was a test. You were happier when trying not to be too perfect. Accepting your flaws made for happier days. Worrying about what you couldn't change did at times get the best of you. Then again, a drive toward perfection brought out your best mental intensity. Finding the balance was the key. Heaven on earth was when you worked at careers or jobs that allowed you to operate from your highest levels of learning.

**7th House: Relationships, marriage, partnerships, social awareness.
Gemini on 7th house:**

People always fascinated you. You were attracted to individuals with intelligence and openness to new ideas. There was a leaning toward wanting to relate to a wide group of peers. This was due to a need for stimulation from people of various backgrounds. A gregarious nature did bring friends from many different walks of life. You tended to be more loyal to those respecting your need to think as an individual. If you did express a lack of commitment in relationships, it was your way of either rebelling or simply not wanting to be tied to one person. You felt closer to those individuals able to see the real you, reflected in your deepest thoughts. You usually possessed a keen wit. Insight into the motivations of others was by your side on numerous occasions.

**8th House: Power, joint resources, rebirth, passion, self-mastery.
Taurus on 8th house:**

You were involved in powerful relationships as a repeating theme. A tendency to indulge heavily in physical appetites sometimes occurred. Learning moderation proved wise. A tenacity to force things to go your way was a trait. A tendency to be secretive regarding money was your usual way of operating. It was betrayals in this area that caused you to be cautious. There was a tendency to lean too heavily on others for support. You did better when not becoming overly reliant. It's just as true that people did abuse your generosity. You felt wonderful when finding individuals worthy of your trust. You showed a steady tenacity in solving problems. Compulsive desires sometimes occurred due to failed love affairs or personal lack of fulfillment. You flew high when finding inspiring outlets for a tremendous creative drive that loved to feel needed.

**9th House: travel, learning, philosophy, knowledge, optimism.
Aries on 9th house:**

A readiness to seek adventure colored past lives. Long distance travel was accentuated. A restless desire for learning was highlighted. Your attention span lengthened when subjects of interest truly captured your imagination. You forcefully expressed your ideas. Debating with others stimulated you. You usually made others happy when you were open to opposing viewpoints. Fighting for narrow focuses or irrational ideas distanced you from people. A passion to prove you were right brought resistance. Being happy with everyday life wasn't easy. As long as you knew change was right around the corner, you were more content.

10th House: Professions, ambition, leadership, focus, commitments.

Pisces on 10th house:

Idealism ran throughout any role you chose. It was never easy to separate out your emotions from whatever you had put your teeth into. You went through a certain amount of anguish in trying to rise to the top of a career ladder. Perfection was somewhat maddening. When you were grounded and disciplined, you could do almost anything you set your mind to doing. Guilt was a challenge in that you felt too responsible for others. When you denied your intuition confusion resulted. Even when working at everyday types of occupations, your idealism was at the heart of your actions.

11th house: Goals, individuality, freedom, inventive, progressive, unique.

Aquarius on 11th house:

You didn't like to do the same thing repetitively. Variety truly was the spice of life in your opinion. Individuality meant a lot to you. When you tried too hard to belong to the pack or tribe, you lost your mental edge. Your unpredictability made others uneasy, even yourself at times. You either loved or feared the future. It was when you were too attached to comfort zones that change was threatening. You didn't like budging if not on your own terms. Original ideas sparked your mental currents. When you broke free from excessive fear of ridicule, you showed a fervent expressive spirit. It wasn't the predictable life events that interested you. It was those sudden surges of new trends that were exhilarating. You sometimes did wish you had reflected before following a whim. You would look out to that distant horizon when things grew calm, wondering when the next signs of change were coming, and better yet, in what form.

12th house: Idealism, intuition, escape, faith, beliefs.

Sagittarius on 12th house:

You had ideals that reached to the farthest horizons. Faith was what you relied on to get you through the tough tests. A dedication to causes was intense. You did sometimes give too much of yourself and regret it later. Reality testing helped you in ascertaining how to define your boundaries. When you went through periods of

self-doubt, your way out of this maze was to travel. A search for a soul mate usually began early. You liked to share your life with a lively partner. Knowing your limitations took time. Testing fate just for the experience happened with regularity. Your ideals had to be grounded. A divine discontent did occasionally make it hard to focus on plans for long periods of time. With practice, you learned how to follow through on what people expected of you. A need for escape was a primal call from within you. Making peace with your intuitive imagination and life's demands was a lifelong process.

Planets in actuality never really move backward, but can appear to do so. This is referred to as retrograde motion, and as you will read has special past life meaning surrounding a particular planet's symbolism. The following are planets that were moving retrograde at your birth with a description as to how this played out for you in other incarnations.

Jupiter retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had a challenge in not foolishly believing in the wrong things or people. When you were on target and accurately assessing situations, you were a dynamo of efficiency and inspiration. Another challenge was in the area of confidence. When you lost faith it took the wind out of your sails. The search for an expansive enough vision was an innate drive. People didn't respond as well if you preached dogma or grew too judgmental. When you kept an open mind there was less friction. You had a capacity to embrace a positive outlook, that is, if self-doubt didn't seep into your thinking. Another challenge was running too fast to where the grass might be greener, running away from facing problems. The optimist in you needed to know limits. When you walked with commonsense and put your ideas into worthwhile actions, the world had no choice but to eventually give into your needs for self-discovery.

Uranus Retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had unique goals, reserved just for you. When you didn't do this, life lacked meaning. When you solely served your own purposes this caused quite a ruffle in the feathers of those you loved and cared

about. Finding the midstream worked the best regarding these two extremes of sacrifice and doing your own thing. Your ideas sent shock waves at times when individuals or collective bodies didn't like the message. You did sometimes tap into a collective trend before it became in vogue. It did make you nervous about how you might be judged. Many ideas were kept internalized until you were sure the coast was clear and safe enough to present the notions. Were you ever more outwardly disruptive? For sure! This usually occurred when you were so aroused by injustices or thinking restrictions imposed upon you. There was a need to perceive with fore thought, which fights were worth the struggle. Being different just to be different or starting conflicts with no purpose, were ways you took many steps in the wrong direction. Listening to cues from the universe on which directions promised accelerated growth was wise. Your vision of the future was as strong as the ability to remember what gave your imagination an electrifying sensation. Patience took effort!

Neptune Retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you needed to watch out what you asked life for. Do you know why? Because you were apt to get it! A tendency to have a strong intuitive quality was a past pattern. In some incarnations you were quite the poet, artist, entertainer or mystic. Perfection wasn't so nice to you in that divine discontent was troublesome, making it a challenge to be satisfied. When you were reasonable or grounded, life was simpler. Getting focused occurred after becoming inspired. There were times when you had premonitions of things to come. This either gave you great faith or was scary. The more you accepted your sixth sense, the easier it was to express outwardly. Another challenge was achieving discipline and utilizing reality testing. When you made a commitment not to run away from conflict, you found clarity. When letting your ideals guide you, life seemed more magical and full of inspiring symbols. Belief in a higher power sustained you through many tough challenges. Lovers were inspirational in stimulating your creativity. You liked the idea of a special someone with whom to share your dreams. Developing a spiritual understanding and a sacred place within kept you walking on the straight and narrow with great awareness, pointing you to pleasurable escapes, and kept you guilt-free.

Pluto retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern to know your way around Intensity Street. In some

lives you were overpowering. In others, you didn't usurp enough power. Having a sense of empowerment was crucial to reaching self-mastery. Survival instincts you possessed. Being emotionally intense was a past pattern. Learning to communicate your feelings made you easier to understand. Self-honesty was liberating but it was a test to admit your faults. Defensiveness had to be conquered. You didn't believe in going halfway when exploring a subject. Compulsive lusts for riches and leadership sometimes brought out your worst manipulative traits. You were happier when feeling inwardly secure and having allies that you could trust. You had to beware of an urge to win at all costs. You found rebirth through not fearing your own shadows, and being big enough not to run from those you loved. You processed experiences long after they occurred, revisiting the past often, healed when able to embrace forgiveness.

Hopefully you have enjoyed your tour through this report. Remember that astrology's language is a great teacher. There are many other reports that you can explore.
